14. Kenny McClaren

Larry Holland talked to Kyle – there's a dispute between neighbors to Holland is trying to switch around water times so they don't have to deal with each other. Ken McClaran water time moved up after Brennon Owens and before Shelly Egge. The water will always be in the same valve its always been in.

15. Excavator

Vance will call Eric and let him know we're in. Eric wants us to be aware of the capacity of the two machines; John Deere 350 is a heavier machine. Most of the projects they looked at in Taylor will work well with the 350. The other machine has a 52' ground reach and should work well to knock the beaver dams out. 3 days on each place – 6 total days total. Beaver dams are the priority. \$12,000. City gave the ok to start.

Kyle – says leave the excavator on the agenda so we can look around at pricing. Vance says a CAT 320 or 325 (maybe a better fit) would be a good fit – that way its not too big. Have to have someone else haul it around (around \$400). Ross's concern is to make sure that we have a good list of who at the city can use it/when they can use it. Who is responsible for maintaining? Probably will be paying \$100k for a decent one. Terry will contact nephew to see what he has available/knows of. Will check with the city and flood district to see what they would be willing to chip in to purchase.

Vance motioned to go in with Town and Snowflake and Town of Taylor to purchase excavator; Terry seconded – all approved.

16. Beavers

Vance talked to Sol – he will start up again. Already has some traps set.

Vance told him to start up at Bill Solomon's. Scott Vance and his boys will go out trapping. Brock Ervien will start up with the ones down Larson Lane. Ross suggested spraying and that'll eliminate the beaver's food source and that'll get rid of the beavers.

18. Ross Willis, District Foreman report – irrigation start date? Need to get Shumway Well running, when do we need to start it? Kyle suggests waiting 7 days. Vance suggests not running full ditches and just run the Shumway well – Terry is worried about the well quitting before WML can get all the way down. How do we notify everyone that the first 7 days on the schedule are being skipped?

Terry is worried that the well won't run – they weren't drilled straight and there's some other issues. Willis drilling isn't able to tell if it'll run for a long time or if it'll short out. Terry suggests opening the lake just enough and running the well.

Kyle suggests cracking the lake and not starting any wells. That way W Shumway and the 2 Snowflake ditches all have water.

We will crack the lake on Thursday morning – 7-10 pumps and start the 1 well on Friday to spread the water – Willis drilling want to be there when the well is turned on.

Put message on the website: ½ stream for first turn due to wet conditions and trying to conserve water.
